She said she interacted with 46 people on Friday and Saturday.</p> <p><u>Upcoming projects</u> Several grant projects need Coalition support. They include the 2015 data rollout, development of a recruitment packet for Coalition members, attending town board meetings to introduce officials to SCCUDD.</p> <p><u>Alcohol.</u> Tilden reports that the committee did work with the Montour Falls Firemen’s Festival to update signs for tobacco- and alcohol-free zones. People did notice and were appreciative. Involvement in next year’s Waterfront Festival will be bigger and better. A letter was sent to the Watkins Glen village board opposing a proposed waiver to the open container law for a Chamber of Commerce activity. A news release will be going out soon about increased patrols for drunk driving by the Watkins Glen Police Department, a partnership effort with SCCUDD. Topics for a fall town hall/forum have been discussed.</p> <p><u>Cannabis.</u> Silliman reports the committee is working on raising awareness about the confidential tipline. An advertising and marketing plan is being developed.</p> <p><u>Tobacco.</u> Watson school policies have been reviewed and updates suggested. STAND students are working with Reality Check to focus on youth development and some project ideas.
