<p>Subcommittees Meet & Report Out</p>	<p>Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Tobacco</u> completed the Earth Day Cigarette Butt Pick-Up in Denison Park, they will be promoting World No Tobacco Day on May 31, Sarah and Elizabeth will be presenting at the Fire Chief's Meeting in June regarding Tobacco-Free Grounds, and they were looking at tobacco-free events in Schuyler possibly collaborating with the Alcohol committee on these events. Elizabeth is writing a letter to the editor regarding smoke-free play. She has been to several parks in Schuyler County and found no cigarette butts near the playgrounds. She would like to thank people in the letter as well as offer cessation information. • <u>Outreach</u> completed their presentation to the Bradford Superintendent and the BOE President from Watkins Glen and it went well. They asked good questions, learned more about SCCUDD, and what SCCUDD could offer to their schools. They took information back to their respective schools and Casey sent out follow-up emails thanking them for their time and asking for a follow-up meeting.
