The Town of Orange is interested in adopting a new policy. They are looking for gaps and room for improvement in other municipalities. Reality Check will be participating in #SeenEnoughTobacco on 10/13/17. They are looking to do a zombie fun run/walk and tabling at Tanglewood. • Outreach Bradford will start the Too Good for Drugs Program in grades K, 1, 2, 7, and 10 in October. Casey, Gretchen, and Mel met with representatives from the Watkins Glen Elementary School to see about supplementing their curriculum with out programs. This will be put on hold until the curriculum review board has time to properly examine it. • Alcohol The Tip-Line and more alcohol social media posts were added to our Facebook and Twitter feeds.
