### COVID-19 Cases Were Expected

## RISK OF EXPOSURE

### Prolonged, Close Contact with a COVID-19 Case



You are unlikely to catch COVID-19 just by walking past someone in the grocery store who has it. You are most likely to catch it if you spend several minutes in close contact with someone who is sick. We will talk to the person who has COVID-19 and contact people who may have been exposed.

## CLEAN AND DISINFECT

### Kill the Virus



Along with practicing social distancing and limiting contact with others, one of the best ways to stop the spread of COVID-19 is to kill the virus by cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces and washing your hands often for at least 20 seconds.
