

The Assessment Calendar

March 1 st	<p><u>Taxable Status Date:</u> All property must be assessed according to ownership & condition as of Taxable Status Date.</p> <p>Exemption applications are due.</p>
May 1 st	<p><u>Tentative Roll Date:</u> The assessor files the tentative assessment roll; changes can only be made by the Board of Assessment Review.</p>
May	<p><u>Grievance Day:</u> Check with your local town for dates and times of hearings of the Board of Assessment Review.</p>
July 1 st	<p><u>Final Roll Date:</u> The assessor incorporates changes from the Board of Assessment Review.</p>
July 31 st	<p>Last day to file small claims and certiorari assessment challenges (you must have filed a grievance with the Board of Assessment Review to protect your right to judicial review).</p>
September 1 st	<p>School tax bills are the first bills affected by the current assessment roll.</p>
January 1 st	<p>County/Town tax bills.</p>
June 1 st	<p>Village tax bills are levied on the prior year roll.</p>
