Subcommittees: What are they?

Alcohol The alcohol subcommittee concentrates on reducing underage use of alcohol. This subcommittee will work to promote policies and practices at Schuyler County festivals to reduce underage drinking. The subcommittee will also explore the feasibility of a Social Host ordinance.

Tobacco The tobacco subcommittee is dedicated to reducing adolescent use of tobacco products. This subcommittee works closely with the Southern Tier Tobacco Awareness Coalition (STTAC). This subcommittee will address tobacco Point of Sale, train youth to evaluate tobacco marketing along school routes, and plan tobacco holiday events.

THC The THC subcommittee focuses on reducing youth use of marijuana and THC-based substances. This subcommittee will examine current school policies and develop plans to reduce THC use.

Parent The parent subcommittee is working on outreach and organizing a meeting time that will work for more parents.
