WHEREAS, the Schuyler County Weights and Measures Department is dedicated to promoting a fair and equitable marketplace in our County by ensuring equity and fairness in all consumer transactions involving weight, measure, count or pricing, and

WHEREAS, the Schuyler County Legislature authorized by Resolution No. 327-19 the Weights and Measures Department to establish and collect fees for the inspection and testing of all weights and measures devices in Schuyler County per the New York State Weights and Measures Regulation 1 NYCRR 220.3(a), and

WHEREAS, New York State Weights and Measures Regulation 1 NYCRR 220.3(e)(5) provides that device testing fees for municipalities below two million people must be paid within 30 days, with discretion of this Weights and Measures Department to allow 60 days for payment of these fees, and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the County, to insure civil penalties are assessed in a fair and consistent manner and allow for enforcement of the collection of fees for the inspection and testing of all weights and measures devices in Schuyler County, establish Late Device Inspection Payment Penalty (Invoice Fees) procedures and penalties, consistent with 1 NYCRR 220.3(e)(5).

WHEREAS, elder abuse is a global, social, and health and human rights issue that affects millions of older persons around the world and deserves the attention of the international community, and

WHEREAS, it is important to know the signs of elder abuse, which include physical trauma, withdrawal, depression, anxiety and/or fear of family members, friends, caregivers or strangers, and

WHEREAS, elder abuse is a significant public health problem, survivors suffer higher levels of psychological distress, are twice as likely to be hospitalized and face greater risk of an early death than other seniors, and

WHEREAS, public awareness has the potential to increase the identification and reporting of abuse by the public, professionals, and victims themselves, and can act as a catalyst to promote issue-based education and long-term prevention, and

WHEREAS, Schuyler County Department of Social Services wants to recognize the need to protect our older population from abuse.

**LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2021**

A Local Law authorizing 12 and 13-year-old licensed hunters to hunt deer with a firearm or crossbow during hunting season with the supervision of an adult licensed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the County of Schuyler as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The intent of this Local Law is to authorize Schuyler County to permit 12 and 13-year-old individuals to participate in the new and safe hunting opportunities in accordance with Environmental Conservation Law § 11-0935. The enacted 2021-2022 New York State Budget, include a pilot program, allowing the opportunity for young hunters, ages 12 and 13, to hunt deer with firearms and crossbow through 2023 if a county authorizes such action within their municipality. Schuyler County is passing this local law as hunting is a valued tradition for many families, and this new opportunity allows experienced, adult hunters to introduce the value of hunting to the next generation. Furthermore, teaching young people safe, responsible, and ethical hunting practices will ensure a rewarding experience for the youth, while providing quality food to families and contributing to important deer management population control practices. This local law has been reviewed and endorsed by the Schuyler County Clerk, County Sheriff, Undersheriff and County Attorney in their official capacities.

Section 2. Pilot Program Authorization

Pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law, ECL Sec. 11-0935, Schuyler County elects to participate in the temporary program to allow for young hunters, ages twelve (12) and thirteen (13), to hunt deer with a firearm, to include rifles, shotguns, and muzzle loaded firearms or crossbow through 2023.

Section 3. State Requirements to Adhere Once Authorized

Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be allowed to hunt deer with the following requirements to be followed:

- Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be under the supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age 21 years or older, with a rifle, shotgun, or muzzle loading firearm in areas where and during the hunting season in which such firearms may be used, and
- Twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old licensed hunters shall be allowed to hunt deer under the supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age 21 years or older, with a crossbow during the times when other hunters may use crossbows, and
- Supervision of a licensed adult hunter, age twenty-one (21) years or older, with at least three (3) years of experience who exercises dominion and control over the youth hunter at all times is required, and
- All licensed twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old hunters as well as their adult supervisors shall be required to wear fluorescent orange or pink clothing while engaged in hunting to an extent and covering so designated pursuant to the law, rules, and regulations promulgated by the State of New York, and
- All licensed twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old hunters as well as their adult supervisors shall remain at ground level while such youth hunters are hunting deer with a crossbow, rifle, shotgun, or muzzleloader, and
- Notwithstanding any State or Federal Law to the contrary, this local law shall not authorize the hunting of bear by twelve (12) and thirteen (13) year old with a firearm or crossbow.

Section 4. Local Law Filing Requirements

A copy of this local law shall be sent to the New York State Department of Conservation as well as the New York State Department of State

Section 5. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law, or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing and publication in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule.
